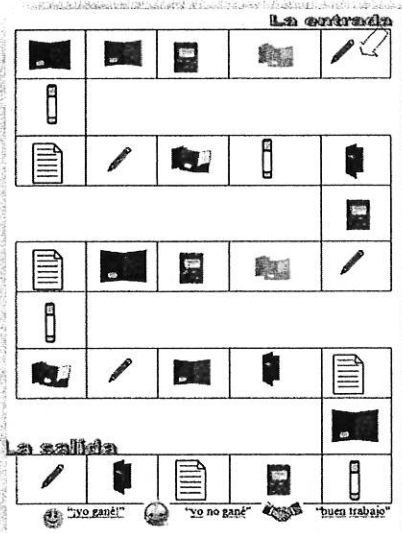
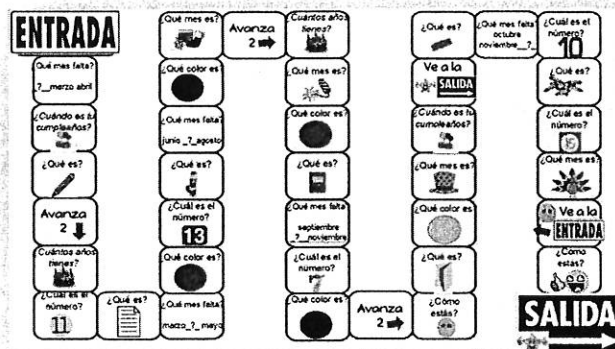


## GAMING IN FLES

My students LOVE to play games. One of the best ways to get them to use authentic language is to let them play games in the FLES classroom. For example: "It's my turn" or "I won!" or "You're cheating!" One of our classroom expectations is NO ENGLISH.
